the interest in and inspiration for this book was derived from the author's background experience and knowledge of adventure expeditions this valuable experience can be detected within the text of this work but its attractiveness is derived from the observation of other experienced members of expedition teams around the world the challenge of adventure expeditions are part of the reason why expedition leaders and team members choose to face unfamiliar situations such as difficult weather or terrain changes in travel plans or using new

equipment and adventurous pursuit in a strange or unknown place the problems to be faced can of course never be fully predicted the challenge of this uncertainty is one of the reasons why people become involved in expeditions but it is also the source of conflict and danger it is the management of these diverse and changing factors that are the concern of the leader a complex and dynamic process it can be implied that adventurous expeditions are demanding experiences full of opportunities and potential problems this later proposition can be justified as a result of previous bad practice and unsavoury incidents within the sphere of outdoor adventure the indications are that expedition leaders need to share good practice and should possess the required leadership qualities they need to consider developing suitable guidelines that could give an outline of the roles and responsibilities of an expedition leader there appears to be a need to identify the desired qualities of expedition leaders in order to develop the essential professional training programmes and safe expeditions that use good practice

the chinese state of the 1920s was one of disunified parts ruled by warlords too strong for civilians to oust and too weak to resist the demands and bribes of foreign powers china s treaty ports were crucibles of change in which congregated the educated elite exposed to modern ways who felt the need for a national revolution to revitalize their country and to provide her with a new more integrated political system nationwide in their origins and representing varying political ideologies this elite formed a loose coalition to achieve a common goal in 1926 the first step in the military campaign known as the northern expedition was launched to conquer the armed forces of the warlords the greatest obstacle in the path toward reunification of china until now historians have ascribed much of the success of the northern expedition culminating in the capture of peking to the communist led mass organizations who were reported to have won over the populace in the territory ahead of the national revolutionary army dr jordan s research especially in communist materials has uncovered evidence indicating that although the mass organizations did aid the army at particular points in 1925 and 1926 there had also been a

side to the mass movement that was disruptive to the goal of reunification of additional import some of the key participants in the later governments of taiwan and peking among them chiang kai shek mao tse tung chou en lai and lin piao received their basic political training in the national revolution

out a pioneering research expedition from 1925 27 to sample the hydrographic structure of the south atlantic ocean its captain fritz spiess was the primary driving force behind the expedition and the german navy supplied the survey ship meteor during this 2.5 year expedition the meteor scientists tested a great many new measurement systems many of which later became routine oceanographic measurement systems as a result of their observations the mean circulation pattern of the atlantic was revealed that has remained valid to this day people interested in the history of ocean exploration the history of earth science and german scientific activity between the world wars will find this volume to be an intriguing read much of the book has been taken from the original cruise report written by captain fritz spiess 1933 in addition his role has been expanded to demonstrate his essential contribution to the creation of the expedition its execution and the dissemination of its results upon completion the present text comments on the captain s life before and after the expedition in 1934 fritz spiess started his second carrier as president of the german marine observatory deutsche seewarte in hamburg a great number of so far unpublished documents demonstrate spiess s ability to run his dignified agency in the turbulent times of nazi germany without becoming a nazi himself readers will learn how this first ocean expedition dedicated to the study of the physics a whole ocean basin helped to provide the background for modern physical oceanography
