the eurozone has exited recession and there are positive indications of progress in countries such as ireland portugal and spain but the report euro area crisis an update hl 163 concludes that the eurozone remains weak and vulnerable despite some countries showing signs of recovery the report finds that fundamental weaknesses still exist such as poor growth huge differences in prosperity between member states destructively high levels of unemployment and growing fears of a deflationary spiral these weaknesses leave the eurozone extremely vulnerable to future shocks the committee also repeats its warning to the government that the uk is becoming increasingly isolated as the euro area knits closer together in order to ensure the uk's interests are effectively promoted the government and the bank of england should maintain and develop constructive relationships with the increasingly

the government s progressive work on tackling violence against women and girls abroad is not translating into its domestic policy despite its violence against women and girls action strategy and the home secretary s personal commitment to the issue the committee warns that failure to provide adequate refuge spaces and specialist services for victims of violence against women and girls demonstrates the difficulty for the government in fulfilling its international obligations under the convention when decisions over commissioning of certain services has been devolved the committee also expresses alarm at the prevalence of violence against women and girls across many cultures in the uk today and heard troubling evidence from many minority groups that represent women with particular needs the portrayal of women as victims of violence is deeply embedded in cultural stereotypes in the depiction of women in the media and in how women are treated in the asylum system this has to stop the committee s recommendations include that schools should play a greater role and include issues of violence against women and girls within the pshe curriculum whilst the government has taken steps to engage with the media and with public awareness campaigns to counteract the sexualised portrayal of women noting that the bbc declined invitations to give evidence to this inquiry the media themselves should do more the government look again at the payment of universal credit to couples because of its concerns that it could put women subject to domestic violence at risk

Lord Hanningfield's case arose after the Daily Mirror published in December 2013 articles about Lord Hanningfield spending short periods of time on the Parliamentary estate in July 2013 whilst claiming the daily allowance of 300 following the articles a complaint was made to the Commissioner for Standards the Commissioner for Standards undertook an investigation which focused on 11 sitting days in July 2013 when Lord Hanningfield was on the Parliamentary estate for fewer than 40 minutes and claimed 300 for each day the Commissioner found that Lord Hanningfield did not undertake Parliamentary work on the days in question and was in breach of the Code of Conduct the sub-committee considered the case and recommended that Lord Hanningfield be required to repay the 3,300 he wrongly claimed and that he be suspended from the service of the House until the end of the current Parliament Lord Hanningfield appealed but the committee did not uphold the appeal and maintained the original recommendation to pay the 3,300 and be suspended from service of the House

It is estimated that at any one time 4,500 EU nationals are held in custody in countries other than their normal place of residence as they are less likely to be granted bail because of a greater perceived risk of absconding the Commission has proposed a European Supervision Order (ESO) which would mean that authorities in a person's home state would also be responsible for returning them for trial this report examines the proposal in detail and makes some recommendations for improvement the committee welcome the proposal and think it deserves prompt attention by member states
