The British Ombudsman... 1973 in may 2011 a british woman ms m who was travelling in egypt was the victim of a sexual assault by a military official she contacted the british embassy in cairo for consular assistance but embassy staff gave her little support at a time when she was frightened and vulnerable ms m complained that embassy staff did not explain clearly how they could help her did not accompany her to report the crime to the police did not arrange a medical examination immediately or offer to accompany her to a hospital and did not know about post exposure prophylaxis a treatment that can prevent hiv infection once the virus has entered the body on her return to the uk ms m complained to the foreign and commonwealth office fco but their initial response was to defend the actions of the embassy in cairo the ombusdman found failings in the way both the british embassy in cairo and the fco in london handled the case instead of giving ms m the help and advice she needed the embassy made a series of assumptions about her ability to cope and was not sensitive to her needs in particular they failed to recognise the context in which the assault took place namely that the assailant was a military official the fco have reviewed the way they handle complaints putting the needs and feelings of the complainant at the centre of the process they have apologised to
