

Free reading Cosmos (2023)

this volume contains essays by some of the leading scholars in the study of the jewish religious ideas in the second temple period that led up to the development of early forms of rabbinic judaism and christianity close attention is paid to the cosmological ideas to be found in the ancient near east and in the hebrew bible and to the manner in which the translators of the hebrew bible into greek reflected the creativity with which judaism engaged hellenistic ideas about the cosmos and the creation the concepts of heaven and divine power human mortality the forces of nature combat myths and the philosophy of wisdom as they occur in 2 maccabees ben sira wisdom of solomon and tobit are carefully analysed and compared with greek and roman world views there are also critical examinations of dead sea scroll texts early jewish prayers and hebrew liturgical poetry and how they these adopt adapt and alter earlier ideas the editors have included appreciations of two major figures who played important roles in the study of the second temple period and in the history and development of the isdcl namely otto kaiser and alexander di lella who died recently and are greatly missed by those in the field in 20 essays inspired by hannah arendt s analysis of crisis ridden modernity wolfgang r heuer addresses aspects of depoliticization and the loss of politics and thus of freedom the wide ranging essays are grouped in five sections when politics vanishes the call of responsibility images and emotions federations and from plurality to cosmos they lead to the insight that the crises of our time require a common change of perspective towards ecological and political

tragic trilogy in relation to presocratic debates about theology and cosmic justice it shows how such scrutiny may affect our understanding of the theological tension and metaphysical assumptions underpinning the oresteia s dramatic narrative ultimately it argues that aeschylus bestows on the experience of human suffering as it is given in the contradictory multiplicity of the world the status of a profound form of knowledge a meeting point between the human and divine spheres environmental philosophy in desperate times examines environmental philosophy in the context of climate denial inaction and thoughtlessness it introduces readers to the varied theories and movements of environmental philosophy but more than that it seeks to unsettle our received understanding of the world and our role in it especially through consideration of indigenous feminist and radical voices this book addresses important current and historical topics in astrobiology and the search for life beyond earth including the search for extraterrestrial intelligence seti the first section covers the plurality of worlds debate from antiquity through the nineteenth century while section two covers the extraterrestrial life debate from the twentieth century to the present the final section examines the societal impact of discovering life beyond earth including both cultural and religious dimensions throughout the book authors draw links between their own chapters and those of other contributors emphasizing the interconnections between the various strands of the history and societal impact of the search for extraterrestrial life the chapters are all written by internationally recognized experts and are carefully edited by douglas vakoch professor of clinical psychology at the california institute of integral studies and director of interstellar message composition at the seti institute this

traces the history of this controversial idea from antiquity to the present ancient greek philosophers first raised the possibility of multiple universes but aristotle insisted on one and only one cosmos then in 1277 the bishop of paris declared it heresy to teach that god could not create as many universes as he pleased unleashing fervent philosophical debate about whether there might exist a plurality of worlds as the middle ages gave way to the renaissance the philosophical debates became more scientific rené descartes declared the number of the heavens to be indefinitely large and as notions of the known universe expanded from our solar system to our galaxy the debate about its multiplicity was repeatedly recast in the 1980s new theories about the big bang reignited interest in the multiverse today the controversy continues as cosmologists and physicists explore the possibility of many big bangs extra dimensions of space and a set of branching parallel universes this engrossing story offers deep lessons about the nature of science and the quest to understand the universe
