the flowering plants angiosperms also known as angiospermae lindley 1830 cantino et al 2007 or magnoliophyta are the most diverse group of land plants with about 350 000 species zeng et al 2014 like gymnosperms angiosperms are seed producing plants they are distinguished from gymnosperms by characteristics including flowers endosperm within the seeds and the production of fruits that contain the seeds etymologically angiosperm means a plant that produces seeds within an enclosure in other words a fruiting plant the term angiosperm comes from the greek composite word angeion case or casing and sperma seed meaning enclosed seeds after the enclosed condition of the seeds en wikipedia org
