the subtitle of this sixth and final volume of the vincentians internationalization and aggiornamento 1919 1980 describes the growth and change of the congregation of the mission in the twentieth century formerly european in focus the provinces of the congregation gained their own voice membership in mission lands such as china brazil and ethiopia surged as local vocations joined their european confreres the same is true of maturing provinces elsewhere st vincent de paul s congregation became internationalized in both outreach and membership the vincentians in these recent decades also tasted the bitterness of persecution the congregation was suppressed at various times in europe latin america asia and africa its members often reacted by moving elsewhere thus furthering the internationalization of the vincentian charism under the nazis and communist regimes many suffered imprisonment torture and death the provinces of central europe slovakia hungary and poland to say nothing of china were particularly hard hit updating aggiornamento was the watchword toward the close of this period as society changed so did the church and with it the vincentians the process was difficult and painful but it moved the congregation in directions originally laid down by the founder increasingly the members emphasized mutual cooperation with many vincentian inspired lay organizations the vincentian family the inspiration shared among them all has been a further manifestation of the compelling insights of st vincent de paul

there is a longstanding scholarly debate on the nature of prophecy in ancient israel until now no study has based itself on the semantics of the hebrew lexeme nābî prophet this investigation by william I kelly discusses the nature and function of prophecy in the corpus of the hebrew book of jeremiah it analyses all occurrences of nābî in jeremiah and performs a close reading of three primary texts jeremiah 1 4 19 23 9 40 and 27 1 28 17 the result is a detailed explanation of how prophecy works and what it meant to call someone a nābî in ancient israel combining the results of the semantic analysis and close readings the study reaches conclusions for six main areas of study 1 the function and nature of prophecy 2 dreams and visions 3 being sent 4 prophets priests and cult 5 salvation and doom and 6 legitimacy and authority these conclusions explain the conceptual categories related to nābî in the corpus i then situate these findings in two current debates one on the definition of nābî and one on cultic prophecy this study contributes to critical scholarship on prophecy in the ancient world on the book of jeremiah and on prophets in ancient israel it is the first major study to analyse nābî' based on its semantic associations it adds to a growing consensus which understands prophecy as a form of divination contrary to some trends in jeremiah scholarship this work demonstrates the importance of a close reading of the masoretic hebrew text this study uses a method of a general nature which can be applied to other texts thus there are significant implications for further research on prophecy and prophetic literature
